To help your child maintain academic integrity, remind him/her to avoid the following behaviors.

- Cheat or helping others cheat on a test
- Copy something from the internet or another source without acknowledgement
- Receive information about a test from someone who's already taken it
- Summarize another's ideas without recognizing where they came from
- Copy someone else's homework
- Provide false information or excuses for incomplete assignments or absences
