Honors Band 6

Student must participate in a solo performance.

Student must focus study on highly advanced music skills, techniques, and processes through the use of composition and/or arranging AND use current technology to enhance creativity and performance effectiveness.

An independent study project must be completed.
This project can be in the form of technology, service based, or another final product as approved by the band director.

Student must attend a concert once a quarter outside of their high school.

Student leadership through peer mentoring, solo work and participation as a performer or coach in a small or large ensemble is required.

Student must demonstrate mastery of advanced scales as selected by the band director.
