The Associate in Arts (AA) degree is designed to prepare a student for entry into the junior year in an appropriate baccalaureate program.

(AA) advising tracks (University transfer Degree)

### ABOUT AN ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE



The Associate in Science (AS) degrees are designed to prepare a student for immediate entry or advancement into employment requiring specialized skills.

(AS) prepares students for a career in two years

# ABOUT CAREER AND TECHNICAL CERTIFICATES

**(VC) Programs** 



The Career and Technical Certificate (VC)
Programs prepare students for careers that provide direct entry into the workforce.

(VC) prepares students for a career in 3 semesters or less

- ✓ Unweighted HS GPA of 3.0 for AA and AS Programs or HS GPA of 2.0 for vocational programs (CTE)
- ✓ Students must meet the minimum scores required in Reading, English and Math to attend classes at PSC locations or online

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


### **Application Process:**<u>Public and Private</u> School Students

- ✓ Meet with your high school guidance counselor
- ✓ Complete testing
- ✓ Complete the PSC dual enrollment application online
- ✓ Check your personal email for Workday and Piratemail login instructions.









- → 3. Complete The PSC Dual Enrollment Application Online
- Complete the PSC Dual Enrollment Application\* (3-5 days for application to process)
- If you are applying for college credit classes, provide the following answers on the application:
  - Academic Level = Undergraduate
  - Student Type = Dual Enrollment
  - Program of Study = Dual Enrollment AA OR Dual Enrollment AS
- If you select Dual Enrollment AS you will need to select your specific program in the Advising Track drop down that appears.
  - Anticipated Start Date = Earliest semester in which you might start classes
  - Campus Location = Choose any, you can still take classes at your high school, any of our campuses, or online
- If you are applying for a career and technical certificate program, provide the following answers on the application:
  - · Academic Level = Vocational
  - Applicant Type = Dual Enrollment
  - Program of Study = Dual Enrollment Career Certificate
  - Advising Track = The program you are applying to
  - · Anticipated Start Date = Earliest semester in which you might start classes.
  - Campus Location = Any campus location of your choosing

#### To Create an Account

- 1. Click "Sign In" in the top right corner of the screen.

- 3. Enter a valid email address\* and create a password.
- 4. Click "Create Account." A verification e-mail will be sent to the e-mail address you provided. 5. From the verification email, click the link to verify your account and sign in. This link is only active for only 24 hours. After 24 hours, click "Forgot Password" to regenerate the verification email. Once you are signed in, click the appropriate admissions application to begin a new application or to complete one previously started.
- \* If you do not have a valid email address, create one for free at Google, Outlook, or Yahoo.

## STUDENT EXPECTATIONS for participating in Dual Enrollment at PSC



- ✓ Attend every class. Be on time and stay for the entire class.
- ✓ Be prepared for class. Complete reading and writing assignments beforehand.
- ✓ Be respectful in class.
- ✓ Engage in class discussions.
- ✓ Wear appropriate attire.
- ✓ Check your Pirate Mail weekly.



## MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY for participating in Dual Enrollment at PSC



- ✓ Pass all classes with a C grade or higher (no D, F, or withdrawal grades)
- ✓ Maintain a college GPA of 2.5 or higher and a high school unweighted GPA of 3.0
- ✓ Students who do not meet these requirements will be limited to taking dual enrollment classes at their high school the following semester or lose access to dual enrollment respectively.
