Call to Order: Marcel Davis, Chair called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Agenda: Pleasant Grove Attendance Zone discussion was held. Mr. Shawn Dennis walked through the attendance zone recommendation worksheet. Examples were given for clarification like receiving zone/ Pleasant Grove should leave some capacity left open for future students.

SAZAC Changes: Pleasant Grove number of students 538 expansion or correction factor. October factor & attendance zone enrollment divided. Ex. New Pleasant Grove 116 x (.64) = 74 the .64 represents the attending students.

The top 3 schools' children choice into plus attendance zone school. This is why we use the correction factor.

Receiving number 801 is the capacity. The other numbers represent each of the other schools.

532 current – 150 outside or choice in Pleasant Grove.

Ex. A 4th grader child may not attend and uproot from his/her present school to attend the new school for a kindergarten sibling.

Blue Angels- The one area we are absorbing will not go.

Semi negative - New Pleasant Grove

The number is the best case for the worse scenario 538 - 167 - 74

Paul did a presentation showing the Before Map.

The district bought the property intentionally = All yellow, study area Helen Caro

Blue Angels – Study area + 0 student = swamp

Reside in Pleasant Grove but can Grandfather Caro for 5 years if already kindergarten. Grandfather (parents take to a current bus stop).
