3 credits— Social Studies, to **include:** World History, US History (EOC—30%), US Government, Economics w/Financial Lit.

1.5 credits— Physical Education to **include** Personal Fitness

1 credit— Fine/Performing Arts or Practical Art substitute

7.5 Credits— Elective

Must have cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher

Must pass 10th grade reading BEST and Algebra I EOC or earn concordant scores!
