G.E.D. Enrollment Steps

GED CLASSES provide education for adults, 16 years old and older, to obtain the necessary skills to pass the GED assessment and earn a high school diploma. The GED Program is open entry/open exit and students may enroll throughout the semester.

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

1. Complete an Online Application

Complete the online application by visiting <u>www.GeorgeStoneCollege.edu</u>. On the home page under Enrollment Process, click the link that shows: Online Application. Complete online application and record student I.D. number or take a picture of it.

2. Take the TABE test

Complete the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE). Testing is usually available in the Assessment Center at GSTC on Tuesdays and Fridays at 7:45 AM only. Testing fee is \$15, payable by cash or money order, and is due at the time of testing. Testers must bring a photo I.D. and social security number. Testers will receive their scores immediately after completing the test. Please contact the Assessment Center at 850-941-6200 ext.2160 to pre-register and confirm dates and times. The online application must be completed before you pre-register to take the TABE test.

3. Meet with a Counselor

After steps 1 and 2 are completed, meet with a counselor to schedule your classes. Counselors are available between 8:00 and 4:00 Monday through Friday. Bring your: Withdrawal form from your former

school, TABE scores, a photo I.D., Social Security Card, and \$30 dollars for the class.

4. Pay \$30.00 for Registration

Students will be required to pay a \$30 tuition fee at the time of registration. Acceptable forms of payment are cash, check, or money orders, or credit card. The \$30 registration fee is required for each term the student is enrolled. Term 1 is August to December and Term 2 is January to May. There may be a Term 3 for Summer School. Registration fees are not refundable.
