It's Getting COLD Outside!!




Be sure to have your child's name written in his/her jacket and other winter clothing. Check the lost and found for missing items!

INCLEMENT WEATHER DISMISSAL, ALL walkers will be brought to front of school. Parents will join the car rider line at the front of the school off Cherry Laurel. Parents MUST have the Car Rider tag that was provided at the beginning of the year placed in your front passenger window. Students will be called out when you pull up in the Car Rider Line.

If you do not have the tag- you will have to park and come inside to show ID.

If you have misplaced your car rider tag- now is a good time to request a new one- visit the office to do so. Anyone that picks up your child-MUST have this tag-everyday!

Absenteeism District Policy

Any student who accumulates five (5) unexcused absences in a thirty (30) calendar day period or ten (10) days in a period of ninety (90) calendar days will be referred to an attendance child study team. The student's unresolved or chronic attendance problems, which include excessive tardies and/or early checkouts, will involve District school social workers and a possible referral to the court system. The student's parent/guardian shall be notified, and a meeting will be scheduled to identify potential remedies. This policy applies to absences from individual class periods, as well as to absences from the entire school day. 1003.26, F.S.
