Read Aloud Tips for Families

<u>Make Reading Time a Priority</u>- schedule daily reading time, many find right before bed is a good time.

<u>**Don't be afraid to be silly-**</u> use accents, funny voices, and sound effects to make reading aloud more engaging.

<u>Stay engaged with your listener throughout your reading time</u>- stop from time to time to explain an unfamiliar vocabulary word, discuss an important point, ask your child to make a prediction.

<u>Expect some fidgeting</u>- listening during reading time does not have to be a stationary activity. Work together to find the way that works best for your child.

<u>Allow time for talking about important characters and events in the story</u>what you liked about the story or how you connected with a character in the story.

Coach's Corner

Another important way to survive the winter is making sure you get enough sleep. Sleep plays a major role in your physical and mental health during the colder months. Getting adequate sleep allows your body to rest and fight off any sickness that you may begin to feel. When you don't get enough sleep, it can affect your physical and mental health.
