



Dress Code Expectations

It is mandatory that all students wear their ID Badges, on a lanyard, around the neck and visible at all times.

- Students not wearing their badges will be given a dress code violation.
- There will be a weekly grade for badges in research

Hats/hoods/head-coverings are not allowed to be worn indoors. Hats are only allowed on campus during a school sponsored "Hat Day", otherwise, hats should not be brought to school.

Girls Dress Code Reminders:

- Skirts/shorts must be at your fingertips (without pulling down on the clothing) when arms are at the sides.
- Tops must cover your back and front "private" area when wearing leggings.
- Tank tops and spaghetti straps must have a sweater or sweatshirt over the top.
- Jeans or pants that have holes: the holes should be past fingertips when arms are at the sides. If there are holes above the fingertips then another article of clothing must be worn underneath to cover the exposed skin.
- NO pajamas or slippers OR blankets

Boys Dress Code Reminders:

- Shirts must have sleeves.
- No sagging - All pants shall be secured at the waist.
- Underwear shall not be visible.
- Any holes in pants should be below fingertip length.
If there are holes above the fingertips then another article of clothing must be worn underneath to cover the exposed skin.
- NO pajamas or slippers OR blankets
