GET STARTED IN THREE EASY STEPS!

Step 1: LOGGING IN

Student will login using their Escambia County School District Single Sign-on Procedures

1. Go to It's Learning (Core LMS)



2. Login using your District Single Sign-On

STEP 2: LOG READING ANYTIME AND WRITE REVIEWS

Once logged in, click the “Log Reading” button at the top of your screen. Add in the number of minutes read plus the title of the book, article, or other reading material.

STEP 3: EARN VIRTUAL BADGES

As each reader logs minutes, virtual badges are earned for up to 10 hours of reading. Of course, you can always read more!



YES! The Beanstack Tracker app is available for FREE to download in the Apple and Google Play Stores.

To log into the app:

1. Search for your school by name under “Schools”.
2. Log in with Clever credentials.
3. Begin by viewing reading challenges, scanning your book’s ISBN number to start a reading session, log that session or other titles, and track your reading streaks.

WHO HAS ACCESS TO MY CHILD’S READING?
