Tate High School Student Photo ID Badge Policy



Purpose and Rationale

Tate High School requires all students to wear a school-issued Photo Identification (ID) badge during the school day. This initiative enhances **campus safety**, **security**, **and operational efficiency**.

Key reasons for the ID policy include:

- 1. **Safety & Security** ID badges make it easy for staff and emergency personnel to quickly identify students and determine who belongs on campus.
- 2. **Operational Efficiency** Badges speed up services such as lunch lines, library checkouts, and event access.
- 3. **School Unity** Wearing ID badges fosters a sense of belonging and pride in the Tate High School community.

Policies and Procedures

Issuance

- To help students adjust to the new Photo ID process, Tate High School will implement a two-week transition period at the start of the policy, beginning on August 14th.
 - If a student forgets their Photo ID during this two-week period:
 - They will be issued a wristband to wear for the day.
 - Wristbands will be distributed by the student's 1st or 2nd period teacher.
 - The wristband serves as a temporary visual identifier for staff and grants the student access to school services for that day only.
 - After the two-week adjustment period, students will be expected to have their Photo ID each day and follow the regular consequences for not having it.
- o IDs include the student's name, student ID, and a barcode for school systems.
- o 1st Replacement is \$5 2nd Replacement is \$10 3rd Replacement & Subsequent \$15

Daily Requirements

- Students must wear their Photo ID badge at all times during the school day.
- IDs must be visible at all times.

Restrictions

- o IDs may not be altered, decorated, or defaced.
- o Duplicate IDs are prohibited.
- \circ Possession of another student's ID is not allowed and will result in disciplinary action.

Replacement & Damaged Cards

- o Damaged or defaced IDs must be replaced at the student's expense.
- Lost IDs should be reported to the *Lost Badge* online form.

Consequences for Not Having an ID

- Will be denied hall pass privileges and senior privileges.
- Will be unable to check out library books.
- May be stopped and questioned regarding their purpose on campus.

Withdrawal from School

 Students must return their Photo ID as part of the withdrawal process. If not, there will be a \$5.00 fee assessed.
