REGISTRATION AND ENROLLMENT STEPS

Step 1: Obtain a VPK Certificate of Eligibility (COE) at <http://familyservices.floridaearlylearning.com> or go to the Early Learning Coalition, 1720 W. Fairfield Drive, Suite 100/400. Monday-Thursday 9:00-3:00, (850) 607-8556. The child's birth certificate and the parent's proof of residence must be uploaded when applying for the Certificate of Eligibility.

Step 2: Complete an Escambia County School District online application in FOCUS at <http://ecsd-fl.schoolloop.com/focuseenrollment>

Step 3: Beginning on April 4, 2022, the parent or guardian brings the following documents to **Spencer Bibbs Center at 2005 N. 6th Avenue** to complete registration. Monday-Thursday, 8:00-3:00.

Schools will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Registration is not complete until all documents have been approved and forms have been signed.

-Bratt and Molino Park will bring the documents directly to the school.

Documents required:

- Certificate of Eligibility
- Birth Certificate
- Proof of Residence (Utility bill or lease)
- Immunization Record
- Physical (or appointment card for upcoming physical)
- Child's Insurance Card*
- Child's Social Security number*
- Proof of Income (2021 W2 for all adults in home)*
