Closed Campus

Northview has a closed campus. Students must stay on the grounds from the time that they arrive, even if the first bell has not yet sounded, until dismissal at bus time or when formally checked out by the attendance clerk. When a student checks out, he/she must leave campus **<u>immediately</u>**. A student may not sign out earlier than the time to leave campus.

Bus Students

By authority of the Florida State Board of Education, a student is privileged to ride a school bus provided he/she lives two or more miles from the school. A student's bus stop is established according to his/her residence. See <u>The School District of Escambia County Rights and Responsibilities Handbook</u>. See the Dean for all bus requests.

Inclement Weather

Before- school procedure is the same as all mornings. When bus students arrive at school, they should report to the gym. As students exit their buses, they should enter the front of the administrative building and go immediately to the gym, <u>or</u> if eating breakfast, they must enter the cafeteria though the sidewalk entrance. Students who drive should arrive on campus on bad weather days at the appropriate time to proceed to either first period or to the gym, if the first bell has not rung.

Loitering in the halls, in the bathrooms, at the end of classroom wings, other non-supervised areas, or in the parked vehicles will<u>not</u> be acceptable. Students must be under the direct supervision of a district employee while on campus, in order to help provide a safe and secure environment for all students.

If bad weather occurs while students are on campus, all students and personnel will follow the appropriate procedures. Teachers and staff are trained in procedures for inclement weather and other emergency situations.
