## Northview High School Tardy Policy 2023-2024

## Tardy to School

- 1. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> unexcused tardy/check-in in one 9 week grading period, the student will be given a minor referral and assigned to lunch detention for 3 days. Any additional unexcused tardy will result in a level 2 major referral for each offense. Unexcused check-ins may occur at any time during the school day and are all included in a student's overall tardy to school count.
- 2. If a student continues to have more unexcused tardies/check-ins, a third major referral will be written. Students will receive 2 days of ISS.
- 3. After the second major referral, if a student continues to have unexcused tardies/check-ins, a parent conference will be scheduled. Additionally, student drivers will lose their parking privileges on campus for 5 school days. (Students in ISS can't participate in any extracurricular activities the day of their scheduled ISS. For sports, this includes both practices and games.)

## Late to Class

Tardies are calculated independently for each period. After accumulating 3 unexcused tardies in one nine week grading period, a minor referral will be written by the teacher, and a student will be assigned to lunch detention for 3 days. Any additional unexcused tardy will result in lunch detention for each offense. (More than 5 minutes late is not considered tardy. Anything past 5 minutes is an out of area infraction.)

## **NHS Lunch Detention**

- Teachers will assign lunch detention to students using the NHS lunch detention slip.
- Students will use this lunch detention slip as a pass to report to the front of the lunch line.
- Students should report to the ISS room immediately upon receiving their lunch.
- Students will turn in their lunch detention slip to Coach Madison, Mr.Cherry, or Coach Summerford for signature. (Completed slips will be placed in teacher's boxes.)

**Student Code of Coduct:** Each school shall have a written tardy procedure which will encourage on-time arrival to school and to class. Each school shall notify students and parents of the school's tardy policy. Each secondary teacher will provide written notice to students regarding the tardy policy to class. Students cannot be suspended out-of-school for tardiness or truancy. 1006.09(1), F.S.
