Parents will need to scan the QR code on the information letter sent home for this event!



Kindness is showing concern about the well-being and feelings of others.

What does Kindness look like?

- ~Refuse to tease of ridicule others.
- ~Show concern when someone is sad.
- ~Do things that meet the needs of others.
- ~Take care of the environment.
- ~Treat everyone fairly.
- ~Do things that make others happy just because you want them to be happy.

What does kindness sound like?

- ~People are king may say things like:
- ~How can I help?
- ~Do you want to join us?
- ~You can go first.
- ~I'm sorry that I hurt your feelings.
- ~Are you okay?

Kindness is all about doing things that will make others happier. Three important parts of kindness are:

- 1. RESPECT- treating people, places, and things with kindness.
- 2. CARING- Feeling and showing concern for others.
- 3. HELPFULNESS- Assisting or serving others in a kind way.
