## Chorus Grading Policy

* Participation/Assessment Grade: 50\% of a student's grade is obtained from assessments in class. This will include, but not be limited to, written music theory practice and exams, sight reading, analysis of observed performance settings, and demonstration of performance skills.
* Performance Grade: 50\% of a student's grade is obtained from performance. Students are given a grade of 100 for performances. If a student is absent from a performance, he/she will be given the opportunity to make up $80 \%$ of the grade by individually singing excerpts from the performance music at a time scheduled outside of class. It is the responsibility of the student to schedule a time for his/her make-up performance grade.
*A zero will be added in the gradebook as a reminder for the student to complete the makeup assignment.


## Chorus Uniform Fees and Fundraising

Each student should contribute an annual chorus uniform fee of $\$ 10$. Extended time for payment or requests for payment options are always welcome. Simply communicate via email to sheath@ecsdfl.us or written note to make requests. Deadline for chorus uniform fee is Friday, September 29, 2023. T-shirt order forms will be sent home requesting sizing and payment.

In addition to monies generated through the chorus fee, chorus will sponsor fundraisers. The Cookie Dough Sale is scheduled for September 1-18, 2023. Additional fundraisers will be scheduled if necessary.

The use of monies collected includes, but is not limited to, the purchase of chorus tee shirts, chorus music, cost of transportation, substitute teachers when chorus is away from campus, concert expenses, classroom materials and supplies, trips, etc. Parents may also make a donation if desired. Checks can be made payable to Beulah Middle School and must include the name, physical address and phone number. No P.O. Boxes allowed.

## CLASSROOM RULES

* Students are considered tardy if not in your seat when the tardy bell rings.
* Students are to remain in their seats at all times unless given permission otherwise.
* Students are expected to have their cell phones turned off unless for an assignment.
* Students are not to bring gum, food, or drink (except water) into the classroom.
* Students are expected to participate at all times to the best of their ability.
* Students are expected to demonstrate rehearsal courtesy.
* Students are expected to respect the learning environment at all times.
* Students are expected to follow all ECSD, and Beulah Middle School policies.


## VIOLATION OF RULES

1. FIRST OFFENSE: Warning and re-teaching of classroom expectations.
2. SECOND OFFENSE: Deduction of merit points in Chorus, and re-teaching of classroom expectations.
3. THIRD OFFENSE: Parent contact, deduction of merit points in Chorus, and re-teaching classroom expectations.
4. FOURTH OFFENSE: Referral/Dean.

## Chorus Classroom Management Procedures

* Students will be given 100 merit points each 9 weeks (cumulative total for the year = 400). (90/100 for $1^{\text {st }}$ nine weeks; $180 / 200$ for $2^{\text {nd }}$ nine weeks; $270 / 300$ for $3^{\text {rd }}$ nine weeks; $360 / 400$ for $4^{\text {th }}$ nine weeks).
* Students will be issued a "yellow card" to be kept in their chorus folders. Any infractions of school rules and/or classroom procedures will result in points deducted from their merit total and will be documented on the yellow card so that students and parents are always aware of their merit point standing. Please check your child's merit point and grade eligibility frequently.
* If a pattern of unwise choices becomes evident, the parent will be notified to discuss possible solutions.
* Students will be given opportunities to regain merit points based on individual circumstances.
* Ten points per day will be deducted for each assigned time in In-School Suspension (ISS) and 20 points per day will be deducted for each day of Out of School Suspension (OSS) if the infraction of rules occurred in the Chorus classroom.


## Chorus Travel Policy

* In order to travel and /or perform off campus, students must maintain $90 \%$ of the total possible merit points ( $90 / 100$ for $1^{\text {st }}$ nine weeks; 180/200 for $2^{\text {nd }}$ nine weeks; 270/300 for $3^{\text {rd }}$ nine weeks; $360 / 400$ for $4^{\text {th }}$ nine weeks). See Chorus Classroom Management Procedures.
* Students must maintain a grade of A, B, or C in all subject areas in order to participate in choral activities off campus. Students will not be allowed off campus privileges during school hours if they have a D or F average in any class.
* Missing a required performance and making up the grade does NOT qualify a student for travel. See Chorus Calendar for designated required performances.


## Chorus Uniforms

Chorus uniform attire:

- Beulah MS Chorus tee shirt. *The Chorus Department will order the t-shirts and students will receive them in Chorus once they've paid the $\$ 10.00$ Chorus $t$-shirt fee.*
- Black jeans to the ankle with no holes.
- Any black tennis shoes or closed toe shoes.
- Hair must be worn out of the face for all performances.
*This year's uniform is subject to change based on the colors of the new Chorus t -shirt. It will likely be very similar to this. Please standby for further information. Thanks!*
