Human gestation is divided into two phases: the embryonic phase, which lasts through the $8^{\text {th }}$ week, and the fetal stage, which lasts from 9 weeks until birth. Most major organs and structures are formed during the embryonic stage. The fetal stage is characterized by rapid growth.
