## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

## Page 1

The following questions have been submitted concerning Bid\#160502, Condiments, Spices, and Staples. Questions\# 1\& 2 have indicated a need to amend the Bid document. Therefore, Amendment No. \#1, Bid\#160502 has been issued. All questions received have been answered, and are provided verbatim from what was received:

BIDDER QUESTION\#1: Question on Item\#71. COOKIE DOUGH, REDUCED FAT, WHOLE GRAIN, FROZEN. Spec reads: All varieties should weigh approximately 1-1.33 oz. Below approved items include our 1.85 oz. cookies. We also do have a 1.33 oz. Wg Cookie which you are currently buying from us. Should we bid both 1.33 oz . \& 1.85 oz .?

Chocolate Chip \#04931 (1.33 oz)
Frozen Candy \#14922 (1.85 oz)
Double Choco Chip Frozen \#14924 (1.85 oz)
Choco Chip Frozen \#14921 (1.85 oz)
Themed Cookie Dough \#74224 (1.85 oz)
The District will accept all bids on cookies that are a minimum of one (1) oz. and meet the USDA Smart Snacks guidelines.

BIDDER QUESTION\#2: Questions on page 97. It says you must have branded merchandising equipment, branded serving bags, and point of sale. What are they looking for? I can have them price it with an acrylic display case 90010, and idea how many.

Also, says must meet 1 grain equivalent, our 1.3 oz . is a $1 / 2$ on the USDA group $E$ except for the sugar, which meets a $1 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{B}$.

For the Point of Sale materials, no acrylic display case, branded bags, and signs/posters either small and/or large are allowed. Bidders should estimate approximately twenty (20) posters and thirty (30) table top tents and/or 8.5 " $\times 11$ " flyers.

The District will accept all bids on cookies meeting nutritional guidelines stated in the specification regardless of offering to meal component (grain/bread).
