QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following questions have been submitted concerning Bid#172202, Cafeteria Equipment. Questions #2 and #3 indicated a need to amend the bid document. Therefore, Amendment No. #1, Bid#172202 has been issued. All questions received have been answered and are stated verbatim from what was received:

<u>BIDDER QUESTION#1</u>: On page 12 of the specifications it is called out "All electrical, gas, and water supply valves shall be furnished and installed by the bidder." As a standard procedure when we are installing equipment, we connect to existing building utilities within 5-6 feet of the equipment, but we do not make any modifications to the building utilities. We always disclaim this so if an electrical, gas, or water line has to be added, moved, or extended in order for us to have the adequate utilities within a reasonable distance to connect the equipment, we are not liable for those modifications. If we need to make minor adjustment at the point of connection, we will, i.e.: replacing an in-line water shut off valve or connecting to an existing electrical box, things like that. I just want to clarify that this is acceptable and we will not be held liable for any extensive building modifications.

Bidders will not be required to do extensive building modifications.

<u>BIDDER QUESTION#2</u>: Item #1 – Beverage Air model #HR2-15 is listed as an acceptable brand. I believe the correct Beverage Air model # is HR2-1S. Please verify.

Yes, the correct model number is HR2-1S. Amendment #1 has been issued.

<u>BIDDER QUESTION#3</u>: Item #13 – No faucet is specified with the tilt skillet. Will a faucet be required, and if so, please verify what type of faucet is to be provided.

Yes, a single valve faucet is required. It is included on Amendment #1.

<u>BIDDER QUESTION#4:</u> Item #32 Acceptable brand is listed as a Lakeside #947, Item #33 Acceptable Brand is listed as Eagle #SPECFAB. I am attaching a drawing of (2) custom fabricated carts that are fabricated by a local custom fab shop. I have recently priced these Escambia County Schools, one of which you have purchased from me. Also, according to the fabricator these have been purchased from another vendor as well. Would these carts be acceptable? They are designed and built per the specification.

Yes, the attached drawings are acceptable.

<u>BIDDER QUESTION/STATEMENT#5</u>: Can a vendor bid on the equipment only without bidding on the install/labor?

Yes, the unit price for the equipment must be all-inclusive: product, shipping and handling, etc.
