IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The four-page FHSA EL2 Physical Form (version “Revised 2/25” or later) is the ONLY form version accepted at this event. Please print single-sided and do not fold pages.
- Parent/Guardian signatures on pages 2 & 4 are REQUIRED for event entry. Parent/Guardian signature on the FHSA EL2 Physical Form provides acknowledgment of consent for the child to receive a sports physical exam. Prior to arrival, parent/guardian should fill out all medical history and demographic information on all pages.
- The pre-participation physical exam includes height, weight, vision, orthopaedic movement screening, blood pressure, and an evaluation by a physician or advanced practice provider.
- Once completed, physical forms will be returned to the student-athlete. Each student-athlete/family is responsible for ensuring the Medical Eligibility Form (page 4 of the EL2 form) is submitted to their school before participation.
- Student-athletes should wear athletic attire and bring/wear any prescription eyewear.
- If a free ECG screening assessment is desired, parent/guardian should also complete and bring the required consent from Who We Play For or complete the pre-registration online at <https://www.whoweplayfor.org/florida-santa-rosa>.
